

Dress code

- All students will adhere to the Sixth Form Business Wear Policy at all times, as detailed below;
- The Sixth Form dress code is smart business attire. Students in Years 12 and 13 are expected to meet the professional business wear expectations as follow:



We interpret business wear as the following;

- Suits with collared shirt and tie or blouse,
- Long trousers with shirt and tie or blouse,
- Dress (knee length),
- Skirt (knee length) with shirt and tie or blouse,
- Neckties, and polo necked sweaters are all acceptable, but open necked attire is not
- Smart Jumpers / Cardigans may be worn but should not have logos/slogans
- Smart/formal shoes



We do not deem the following to be appropriate businesswear;

- Canvas shoes/trainers
- Military / Doc Marten style boots
- Denim / stretchy materialled trousers/skirts
- Leather (or leather look) items
- Hoodies
- Long and/or chunky/oversized jumpers/cardigans
- Jeans / Chinos / Leggings
- Open shirts worn over t-shirts
- Polo t-shirts
- Hats/caps
- Nose rings

If you arrive at school wearing incorrect items, you will be asked to remove the item. If it cannot be removed or replaced, you will be isolated.
