As you will be aware, there are a number of students at Brooke Weston who have severe allergies to nuts and carrots. Some of the students are affected by airborne particles and exposure to these food items can result in hospitalisation so it is important to continue to work together as a community to protect each other.

Recently however, peppers have become another allergen, which has been harmful to some students. The risk of hospitalisation and/or anaphylaxis is a very real risk and we would ask again for your support to alleviate the danger this represents.
