Respect

- ✓ Treat each other with respect and kindness
- ✓ Look after the school environment
- ✓ Be punctual to all lessons
- ✓ Follow adult instructions first time, every time
 - Ensure that language and behaviours are tolerant and not discriminatory in any way
 - ✓ In class:
 - Sit and stay in your assigned seatsit up!
 - Hands up to be heard
 - Stand behind your chair, be silent until dismissed
 - ✓ Chewing gum is not allowed in school
 - Mobile phones should not be seen or heard and must be kept in lockers during the school day
 - ✓ Adhere to the BWA Uniform Expectations
 - ✓ Adhere to the BWA transport expectations
 - Adhere to BWA Acceptable Use of IT policy
 - ✓ Do not participate or condone bullying behaviour

Engage

- Always engage productively in learning and lessons displaying a positive attitude

- Get started- copy down your title & date and start your first activity
- ✓ Actively listen and track your teacher
- ✓ Listen to others
- Engage in the student voice activities to continue to improve the success of the Academy
- Not to disrupt the learning of others

Non-Negotiables

The below behaviours are the non-negotiable behaviours at Brooke Weston Academy that will not be tolerated these are behaviours that if displayed will lead to serious sanctions that could include Permanent exclusion:

- Continued defiance of the Academy expectations
- Any behaviour that jeopardises the safety of a member of the Academy
- * Any behaviour that seriously or continuously impacts the learning of others
- Vaping/ Smoking onsite
- Physical altercations/Fighting
- * Aggressive behaviour verbal or physical to any member of the school community
- Being under the influence of, or bringing drugs or alcohol on school site
- **x** Bringing a weapon on site
- × Behaviour deemed as Harmful Sexual Behaviour
- Identity based incidents (for example racism, homophobic behaviour, sexism)
- Continued/ serious bullying

Consequences

Fair and appropriate consequences will be issued for displaying poor behaviours and breaches of the behaviour policy this could include:

- Restorative outcomes
- Immediate removal from lesson, break or lunch
- Contact home
- Supervised breakfast/ lunch
- Revoking of school bus pass
- Confiscation of items
- Isolation with Tutor, RSL, SLT, VP or Principal
- Suspension
- A permanent exclusion
- Alternative Provision

Possible Support

Support and intervention to prevent suspensions and exclusions could include:

- Restorative action plans
- Mediation
- Monitoring report to Tutor, RSL, SLT, VP or Principal
- Parent/ Guardian meeting
- Behaviour contract
- Inclusion support plan
- External Agency support
- Multi Agency support
- Personalised timetable
- Alternative provision
