Brooke Weston Academy Uniform Expectations

Our standards at Brooke Weston are high and it is these standards that deliver the amazing culture, behaviour and results that we celebrate each year. However, over the course of this term, we have noticed that some students are not meeting our uniform expectations.

We need to ensure that all students are meeting the Brooke Weston Academy standards for uniform. As such, the senior team and Tutors will be checking students' uniform against our uniform policy from Monday of next week. Parents and Carers will be notified if there are concerns or issues with their child's uniform.

The following link <u>Uniform - Brooke Weston Academy</u> will take you to the Academy's uniform policy and we thank you for your support with this and ask that you continue to support us, where necessary, in procuring the correct uniform for your child.

As you will be aware student cards and lanyards are part of the Brooke Weston school uniform. The ID cards play an important role as the cards allow students entry into the Academy, registers them every morning and allows students to buy their lunch and borrow books/laptops from the library. If students lose their card, then parents/carers will need to pay £5 through WisePay to replace it. Students are always expected to wear their lanyard when in the Academy, and if they lose their lanyard then parents/carers will need to pay £2 through WisePay to replace it.

If your child is currently not able to wear the correct uniform and there are barriers to you being able to rectify this, please contact the school and we will attempt to support you to overcome these barriers as repeated incidents of **incorrect uniform will lead to students being isolated**.
