

Sixth Form Dress Code



All students will adhere to the Sixth Form Business Wear Policy at all times, as detailed below;

The Sixth Form dress code is smart business attire. Students in Years 12 and 13 are expected to meet the professional business wear expectations as follow:

- **Trousers:**
 - Suit / tailored trousers
 - No shorts
 - No denim / chinos trousers
 - No leggings / flared trousers
 - No leather or leather look trousers.
- **Dresses / Skirts**
 - Formal / tailored long or short sleeve dresses
 - Shoulders should not be exposed
 - Knee length (no more than 10cm above the knee)
 - No stretchy / jersey materials
- **Shirts / blouses**
 - Long or short sleeve shirt (to be buttoned up and worn with a tie)
 - Blouses and polo-neck jumpers may be worn
 - No low necklines or exposed stomachs
 - No t-shirts or polo-shirts
 - No sports shirts
- **Jumpers / cardigans**
 - Round or V-neck
 - Should not be oversized or baggy
 - No logos
 - No hoodies or sweatshirts
- **Shoes / boots**
 - Formal smart shoes
 - Smart boots are allowed
 - No walking boots, no Doc Marten style boots
 - No trainers
- **Other aspects of appearance and dress**
 - Not hats, caps or head-coverings except for those of religious nature
 - No septum piercings, one small nose stud or ring may be worn
 - Jewellery should be reasonably small and not excessive in quantity
 - Hair should be natural in colour (no red, green, blue, pink, purple etc)
 - Lanyards should be worn at all times
- **If you arrive at school wearing incorrect items, you will be asked to remove the item. If it cannot be removed or replaced, you will be isolated.**
