New Edenred Free School Meal Voucher released this week

As you may be aware, the Brooke Weston Trust has operated a free school meals voucher scheme using a provider called Sodexo. However, in order that we can provide vouchers for the summer holiday period, we must now transfer to a government scheme run by a different company called **Edenred**.

Starting from this **Friday (26th June)** you will receive, via email, an eCode. This is the 16 digit code you will need to access www.freeschoolmeals.co.uk and choose your supermarket eGift card. You cannot use the eCode directly with the retailer, it must be exchanged for an eGift card. It is also worth noting that these eCodes & eGift cards are only **valid for one month**.

Each of the participating supermarkets listed below has their own eGift card. To order your eGift, redeem your eCode at www.freeschoolmeals.co.uk. The eGift card will be sent to the email address entered during check-out and can be spent instore at the chosen supermarket.
